HINDU ORGANIZATIONAL CONFERENCE

The **Hindu Organizational Conference** is being conducted by the Hindu Organizations, Temples, and Associations (HOTA) Forum. The guiding theme of the conference is "*Sanghe Shakti Kaliyuge*", which means "*Organisation is Strength*".

The primary goal of the conference is to provide a platform for all Hindu organizations, associations and institutions that are nobly working to serve Hindu society in their individual capacities. Hence, we are inviting leaders and representatives of various Hindu organizations, temples and associations to this conference.

This is one of the seven conferences of the second World Hindu Congress, with the theme *Sumantrite Suvikrante* (meaning "*Well thought & well executed idea leads to victory*"), to be held at Westin Hotel from 7th to 9th September 2018 in Westin Hotel, Chicago, USA. The other six conferences are: Hindu Economic Conference; Hindu Youth Conference; Hindu Women Conference; Hindu Educational Conference; Hindu Political Conference; and Hindu Media Conference.

We have 6 sessions in the **Hindu Organizational Conference**:

- **Session 1** deals with creating a collaborative platform for different Linguistic Organizations (e.g. US based linguistic organisations of Bharat) to come together and work together for larger Hindu cause and strengthen Hindu society (Panel Discussion). Tamil, Kannada, Marathi, Gujarati, Punjabi, Bengali
- **Session 2** deals with creating a collaborative platform for same Linguistic Organizations (e.g. US based Telugu organisations) to come together and work together for larger Hindu cause and strengthen Hindu society (Panel Discussion). TANA, ATA, NATS, NATA, etc.
- **Session 3:** Can Hindu Organisations work together for the larger Hindu resurgence? (Panel Discussion). Bharat Sevashram Sangh, Chinmaya Mission, Sri Ramakrishna Mission, ISKCON, Art of Living, Ammaji, Gayathri Parivar etc.
- **Session 4** is Developing the combined mechanism and pull resources to make it operational for Hindus to reach the unreached areas, South American community, African society.
- **Session 5** deals with Human rights violation around the world – Hindu organizations actively addressing the issues. The topics include Defending Hindu human rights; and Influencing Government policies defending Hindu human rights. HAF, GHRD,

- **Session 6** deals with Responding to socio-cultural challenges before Hindu Society.
