



## Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP) Application Process

<b>Step 1</b>	<b>Find Your State Administrative Agency (SAA) Contact</b>	<p>Establish contact with the State Administrative Agency (SAA) serving as the primary applicant (i.e., pass-through entity) for the award, to learn about the application deadline and requirements. The SAA establishes the final deadline for the submission of subapplications, which is earlier than the deadline published in the Notice Of Funding Opportunities (NOFO). The NOFO deadline is for SAA's submission of the final application to FEMA.</p>	<a href="#">Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)</a>
<b>Step 2</b>	<b>Get a UEI Number</b>	<p>First, determine whether your organization was previously assigned a Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) Number when applying for federal assistance; the numeric DUNS system was phased out of use on April 4, 2022 and replaced by the alphanumeric Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) system. If your organization was previously assigned a DUNS Number, it has been replaced by a new UEI value. Login to <a href="http://sam.gov">sam.gov</a> to check your new UEI. If your organization has not previously applied for federal assistance, move on to Step 2 below; you will automatically be assigned a UEI when registering in <a href="http://sam.gov">sam.gov</a>.</p> <p>Then, obtain an Employer Identification Number (EIN) and register in the System for Award Management at <a href="http://sam.gov">sam.gov</a>; your organization will be assigned a Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) once registered.</p>	<a href="#">How to get a Unique Entity Identifier (UEI)</a>

<p><b>Step 3</b></p>	<p><b>Prepare Subapplication Materials</b></p>	<p>Work with your State Administrative Agency (SAA) to identify if they have state-required subapplication requirements in addition to what FEMA requires and is listed in the NOFO. Write your mission statement on official letterhead, if available, specifying the “who, what and why” of your organization (FEMA NOFO requirement). This must be submitted to the SAA, but will not be submitted to FEMA. Conduct and/or review your Vulnerability Assessment to assist in identifying the threats, vulnerabilities and consequences of terrorist attacks at your facility and any supporting documents (e.g., police or insurance reports) (FEMA NOFO requirement). Subapplicants should use this information to complete FEMA’s required Investment Justification. Complete the Investment Justification (FEMA NOFO requirement). An Investment Justification can only be for a single physical address for your facility at the time of application; any equipment requested in this Investment Justification should be directly linked to the threats, vulnerabilities, and potential consequences of events as described in the Vulnerability Assessment mentioned above.</p>	<p>Note: Throughout this funding notice, the term “applicant” refers to the SAA, and the term “subapplicant” refers to the nonprofit organization .</p>
<p><b>Step 4</b></p>	<p><b>Submit Your Subapplication</b></p>	<p>Submit your subapplication package to the State Administrative Agency (SAA). The SAA will submit the final application package to FEMA, including your Investment Justification(s).</p>	<p><a href="#">2023 Subapplication guideline</a></p>
<p>The SAA is the only eligible applicant to apply for funding to FEMA. Nonprofit organizations are eligible as subapplicants to the SAA. As such, nonprofit organizations must apply for FY 2022 NSGP through their SAA, who then submits all application information to FEMA.</p>
